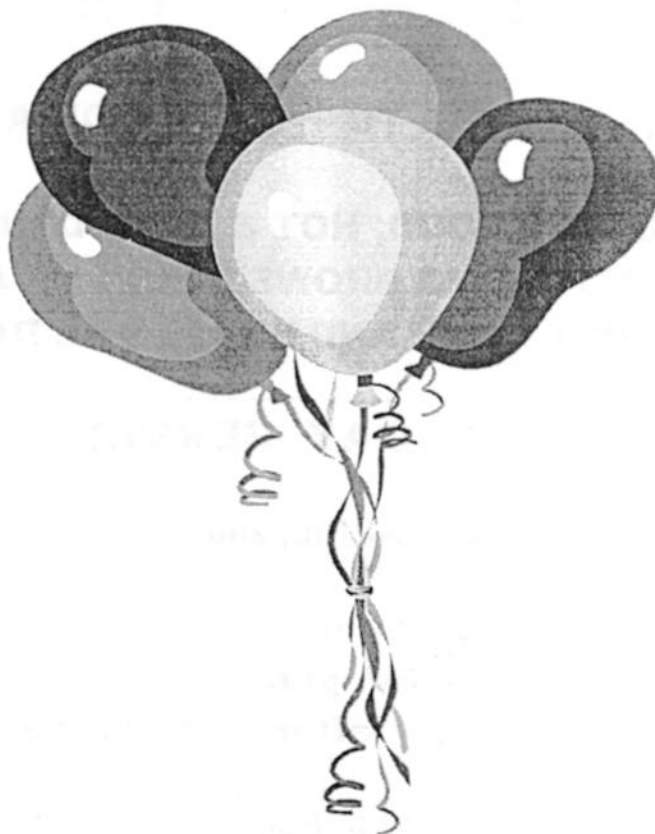

## **Goulburn & District Community Transport Service in the Mulwaree Shire**

Goulburn & District Community Transport Service has now been operating in the Mulwaree Shire for eleven years. During that time many people have travelled with us and we have made some sound friends amongst the regular passengers.

However, there may be some people who are still not fully aware of the different types of transport that we provide.

So perhaps its time to remind everybody in the shire exactly what sort of transport can be provided.

Each Friday after pension Thursday the bus takes elderly people from Marulan to Goulburn for shopping, doctors, hairdresser's etc. The cost is six dollars return. The following Monday the bus travels to Taralga and provides transport to Goulburn. Some people travel just as a social outing.

Transport from outlying villages such as Tarago, Collector etc can be arranged.

If you need long distance transport to medical facilities in Goulburn, Canberra or Sydney the service may be able to assist.

## GARDENING IN APRIL

Vegetables: Broad Beans, unlike other beans, prefer a cool climate and are ready to pick late winter or early spring when vegetables are scarce. Before planting them, give the soil a good liming and also add some complete fertiliser. They don't like a high nitrogen fertiliser as this promotes leaves at the expense of flowers.

Other veggies to plant are peas, cabbage and onions (mainly white and odourless). Greenfeast peas should be sown in tow rows close to each other for support and if you have a fence or wall which gets plenty of winter sunshine, grow Telephone climbing peas, they produce a big crop and are worthwhile growing. They prefer a soil which has had a light dressing of lime and complete fertiliser.

Flowers: Seedlings available now are Alyssum, Canterbury Bells, Carnations, Cornflower, Delphinium, Dianthus, Hollyhock, Russell Lupins, Pansy, Viola, Primula, Snapdragon, Stock and Wallflower.

Seeds of Sweet Pea can now be sown. Like vegetables, they prefer a soil containing compost, lime and a complete fertiliser. When first planting, give them a light watering and no more until they appear through the ground.

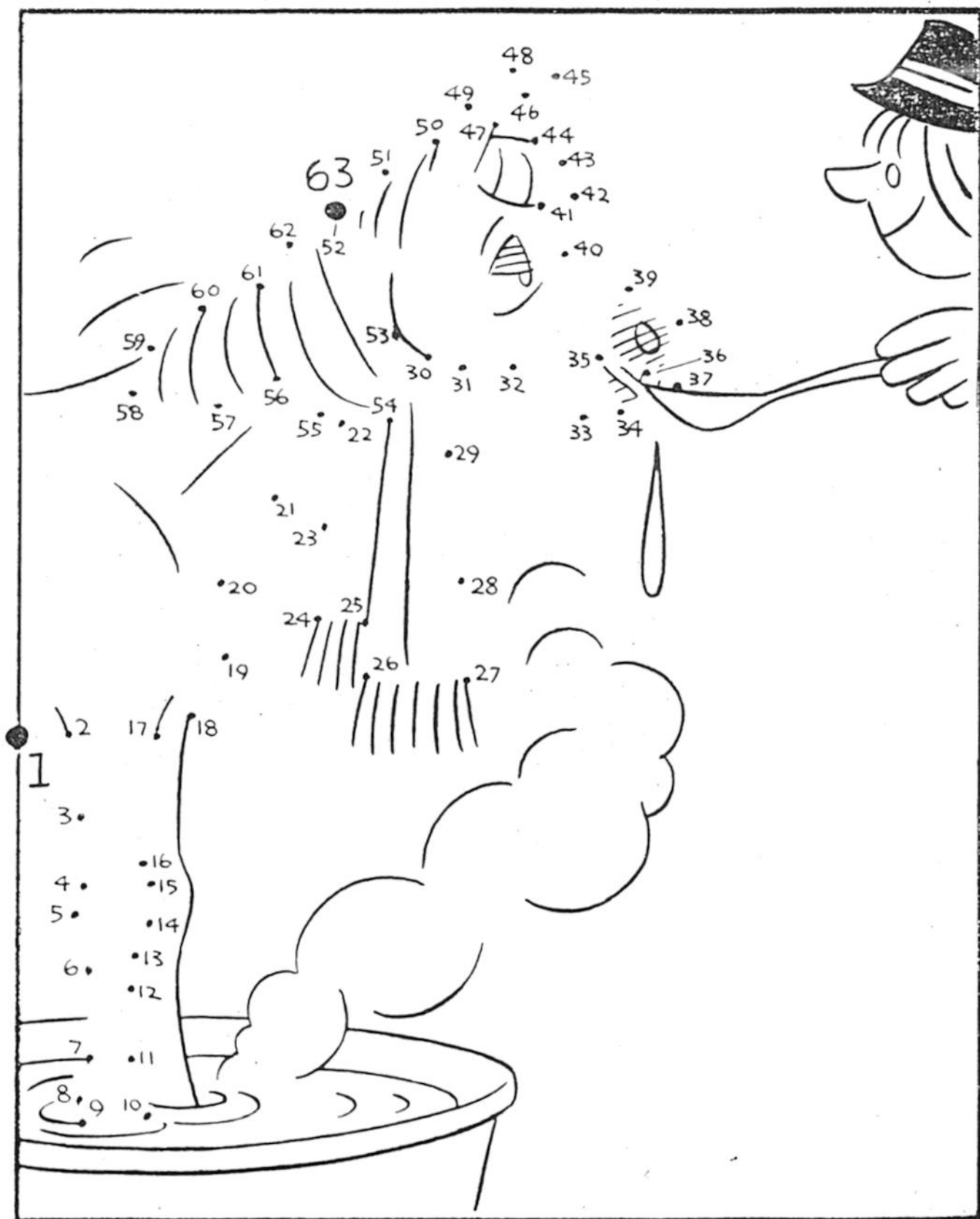

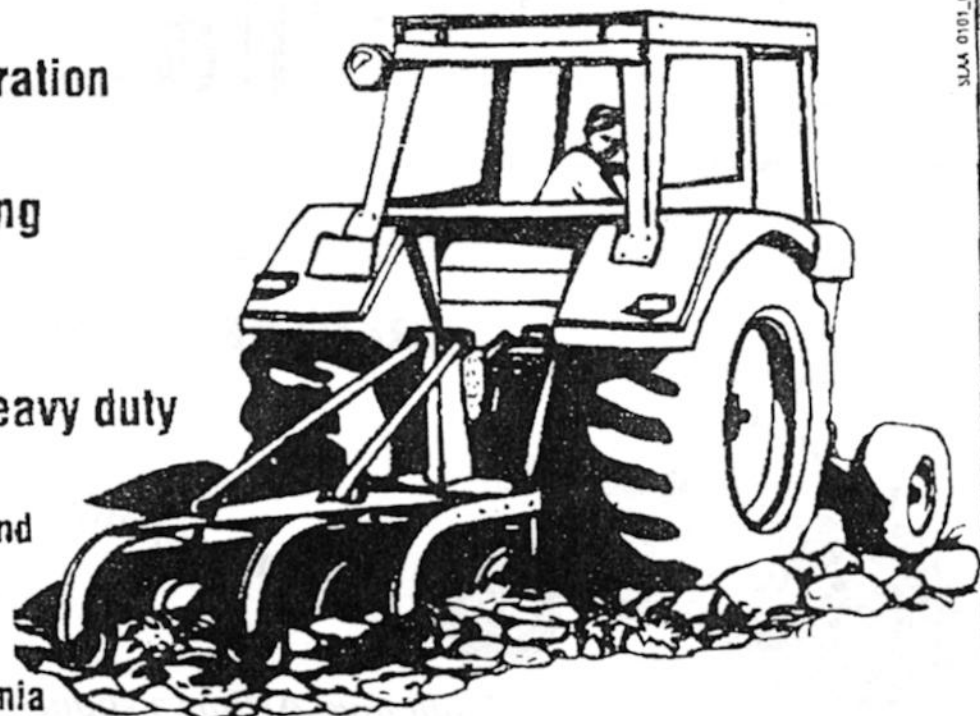

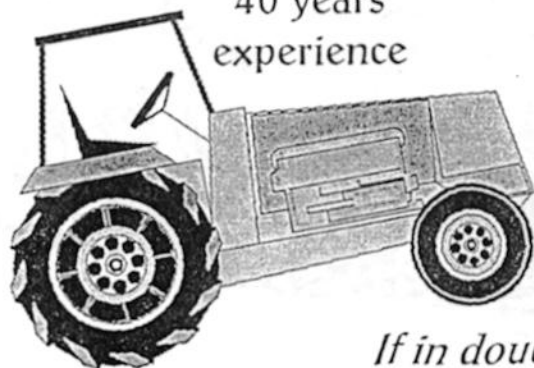
