### **Clean Up Australia Day: SUNDAY 5TH. MARCH**

2. Remove all flammable rubbish from around your house.
3. Keep grass around your house short and watered.
4. When you use your lawn mower, keep water handy.
5. Avoid mowing or slashing on very hot days as this can start fires very quickly.

Please think before you do your jobs around home or anywhere else.
