DO NOT push 90# on your home phone

This has been confirmed by Telstra:

DO NOT push 90# on your home phone. Got a call last night from an individual identifying himself as an AT&T Service technician who was conducting a test on our telephone lines. He stated that to complete the test I should touch nine (9), zero (0), hash (#) and then hang up. Luckily, I was suspicious and refused. Upon contacting the telephone company, I was informed that by pushing 90#, you give the requesting individual full access to your telephone line, which allows them to place long distance telephone calls billed to your home phone number.

I was further informed that this scam has been originating from many of the local jails/prisons. DO NOT press 90# for ANYONE. PLEASE pass this on to your friends. If you have mailing lists and/or newsletters from organisations you are connected with, I encourage you to pass this on.

JACQUA CREEK LANDCARE GROUP

The August meeting of the Landcare Group was held at Ken & Diana Moran's where the group looked at Ken & Diana's current project which covers a three kilometer section of Jacqua creek. Options are being considered as creek bed "controls", possibly rock or timber, to stabilize erosion. Fish passage is an important consideration and Fisheries and Wildlife will help with this. When a section of creek is fenced from stock, alternative low cost watering systems must be installed and rehabilitation of creek banks carried out by replanting trees. Ken & Diana favour planting pioneering species as part of this project. The group has received a grant for further riparian works along the creek. This will enable two properties with a combined 4 kilometers of creek frontage to be fenced against stock. This allows the creek banks to revert to a natural state allowing native species to regenerate. The project also includes providing alternate stock watering areas by installing dams.

The Jacqua Creek Landcare Group is only small. However, it welcomes new members to join its friendly group. The next meeting, and A.G.M., is planned for Saturday 25 October. Why not ring and find out more about the group.
